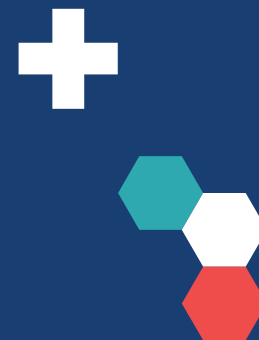

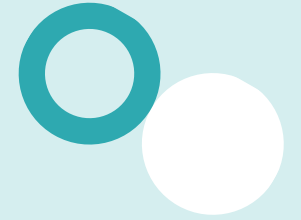

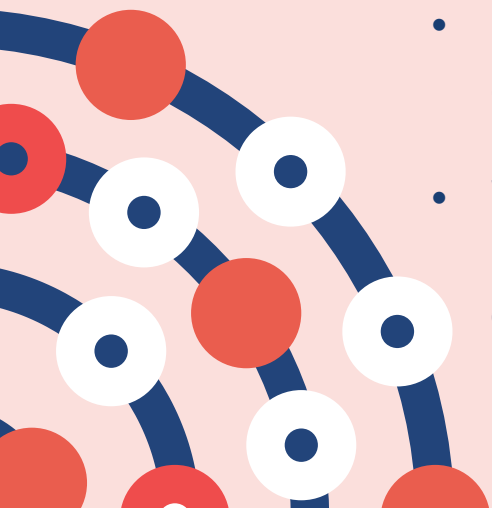
ARC NWC is a collaboration...

ARC NWC consists of health and social care providers, NHS commissioners, local authorities, universities, public advisers, the Innovation Agency or “members”.



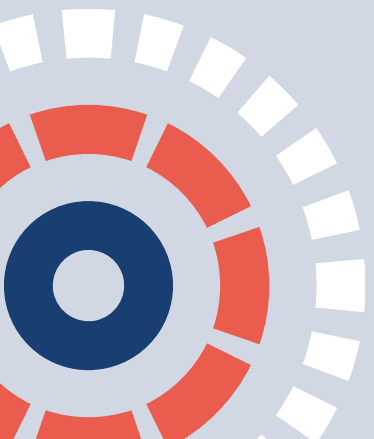
Our offer: Through collaboration with stakeholders, deliver evidence-based improvements in health and social care that address regional and national priorities while effectively reducing health inequalities.

- Themes will develop up ideas at regular meetings in and out of ARCFEST days
- Our themes work with our resource pool themes and implementation team to make an impact or create outputs.
- We offer access to services including in-depth research knowledge, implementation expertise, advice on grant applications, piloting of ideas, evaluations of service, statistical expertise, facilitating stakeholders to make service change, etc.



ARC NWC

- 61 Member Organisations signed up
- The collaboration has four research themes reflecting local needs. These are: 'Person-Centred Complex Care', 'Improving Population Health', 'Health and Care across the Life-course' and 'Equitable Place-based Health and Care'.
- Implementation and Capacity Building Team (IMPACT), create opportunities for members and public advisers to come together and develop skills and expertise, plus increase the rate at which evidence-based interventions are implemented into practice.
- ARC NWC's cross-cutting themes provide expertise and guidance to support research theme activity: 'Care and Health Informatics' and 'Methodological Innovation Development Adaptation and Support'.

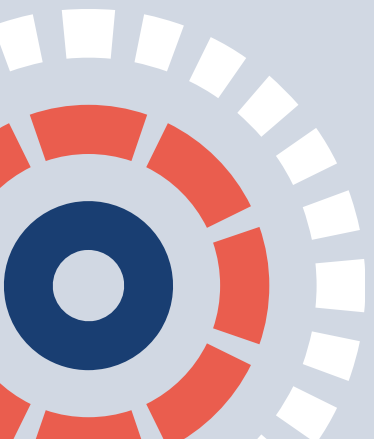


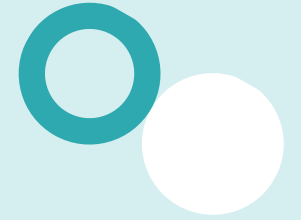

- Below are the ideas from ARCFEST 1 we asked members to rank



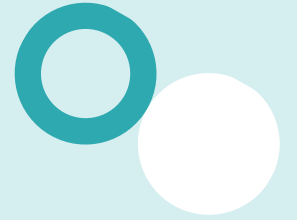
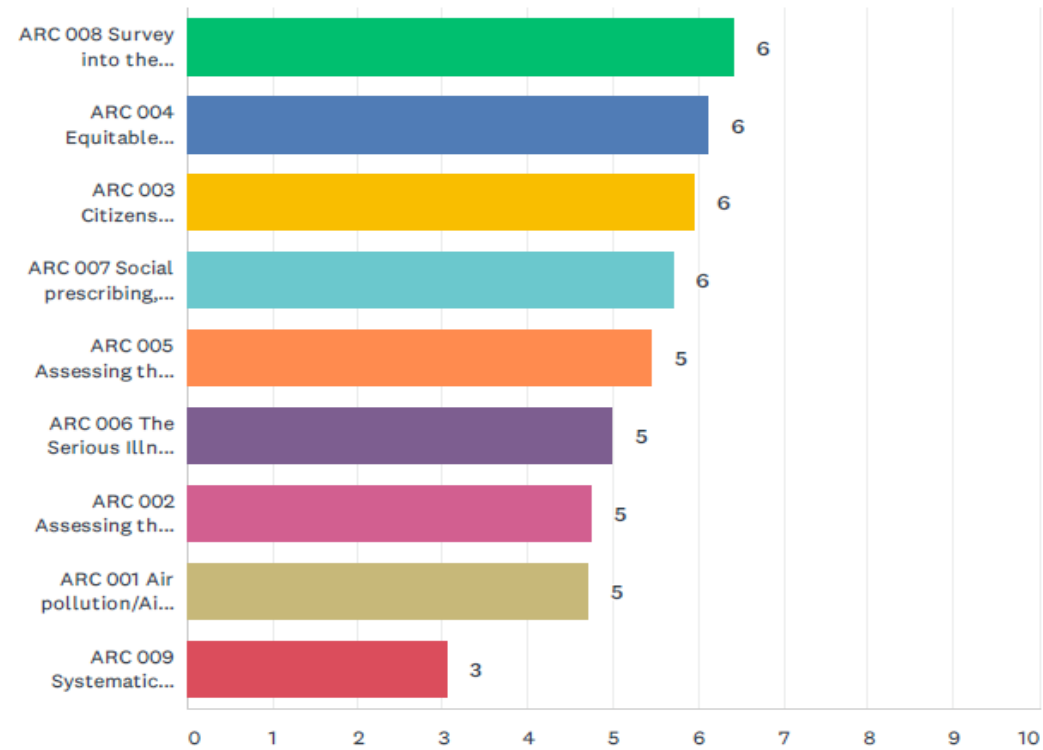

- This format is one route for getting ideas into ARC NWC and collaborative support/buy-in.

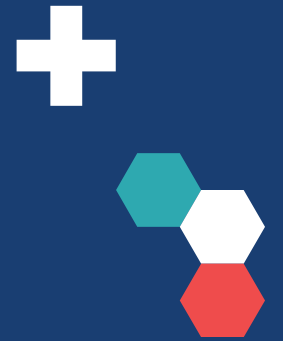

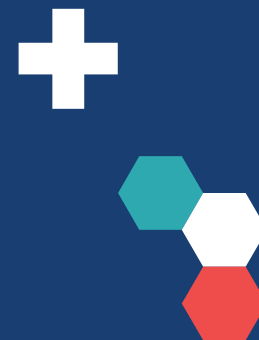
