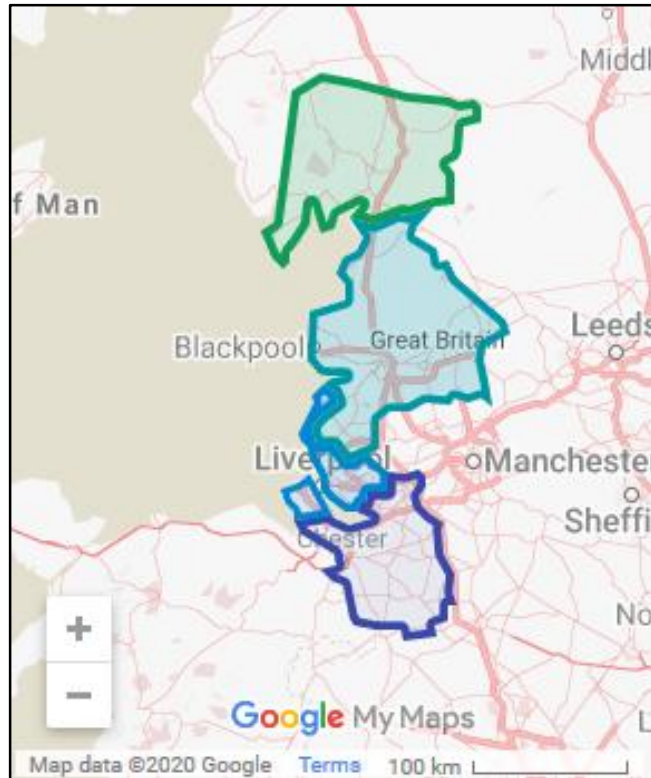


Aims of NWC ARC P&CI EP activities

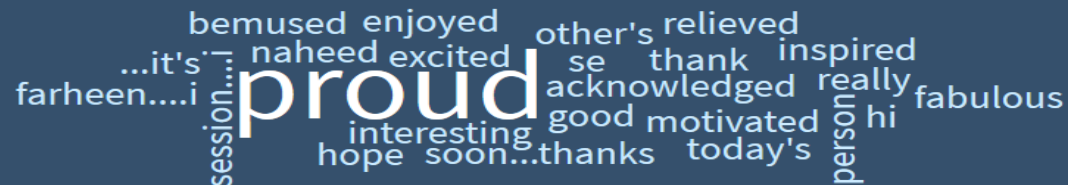

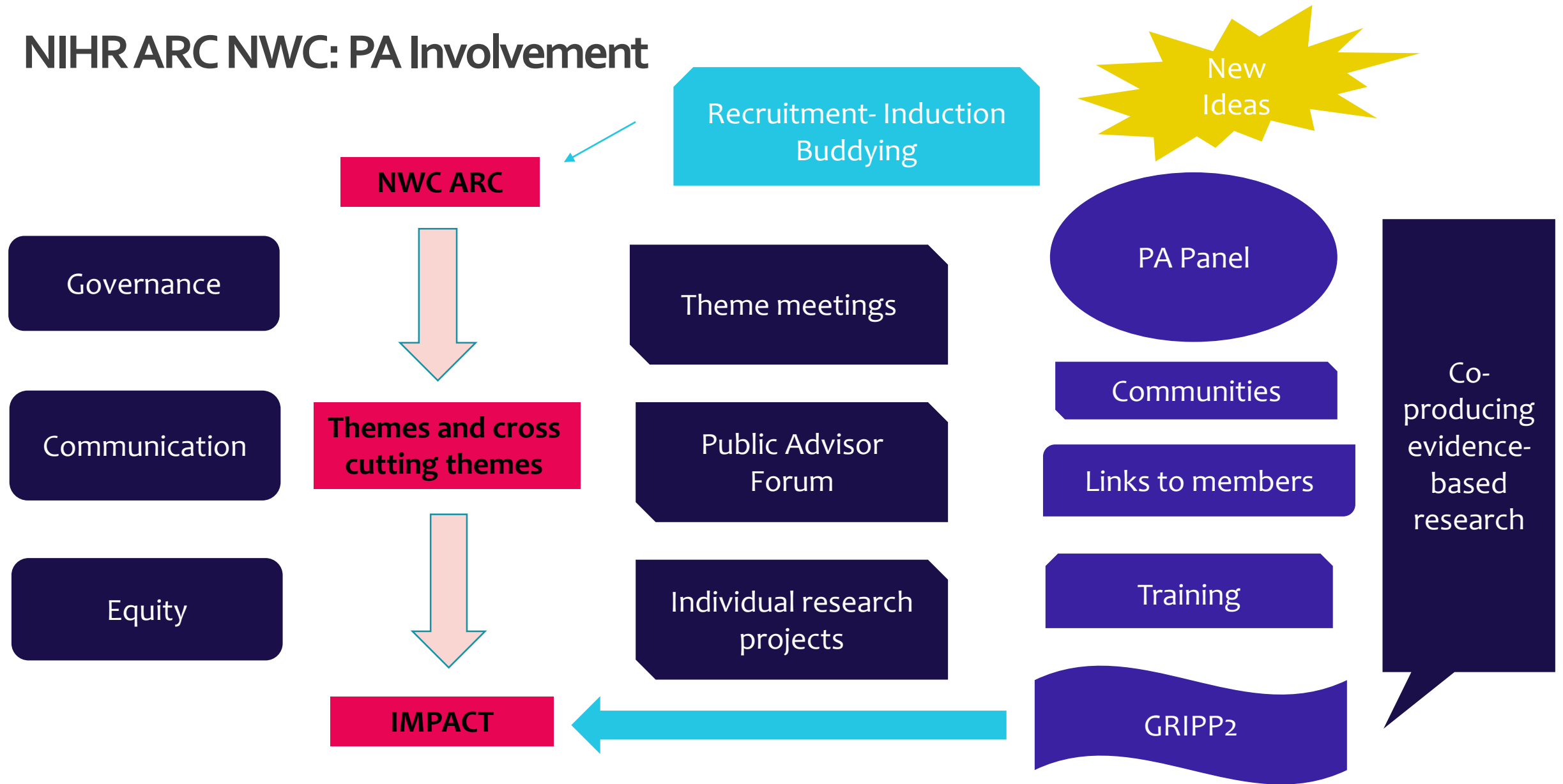
Public Adviser Involvement in ARC
