- LCR has some of the most disadvantaged neighbourhoods in the country with greater risks from COVID and COVID restrictions.
- **Aim:** To understand the psychological and social impact of COVID-19 on household members across a representative range of neighbourhoods within LCR.
- **Objectives:**
 - To assess the impacts of COVID 19, including differences between those who contract and who do not contract Covid-19, by neighbourhood disadvantage.
 - To examine the impact of COVID-19 on individual wellbeing and resilience.
 - To assess changes in loneliness over time as a consequence of COVID 19
 - To examine how tolerance of uncertainty influences individual wellbeing
 - To examine the impact of sense of community on individual wellbeing
 - To examine the individual, community and societal factors which promote or hinder resilience at an individual level during this time.
